(U.C.S. 1907-9)

Rix, Leslie Gordon (U.C.S. 1907-9), Capt. London Regiment, died of wounds on February 11, 1917. For four years he was in the O.T.C., besides playing cricket and football. He showed his keenness by playing for the Old Boys' teams up to 1914. On the outbreak of war he joined the Artists, and was injured whilst playing for them against the London Scottish. He received his commission in the London Regiment in February, 1915, went to the front in April, and was promoted full Lieutenant in June, 1915, and Captain in October of the same year. House λ.
